How to support your child at home

Curriculum

Mathematics and Numeracy

We will continue to use a range of resources from our Abacus schemes. These aim to accelerate pupils' mathematical skills and provide them with authentic contexts in which to develop their knowledge of the number system.

Language, Literacy and Communication

Our focus this term will be writing letters and recounts.

Welsh

Our Welsh topics this term is 'Amser', 'Teledu' and 'Hamdden'. Pupils will be learning vocabulary about their daily routines, interests and hobbies. This term we will also be learning basic Spanish: introducing pupils to simple greetings, numbers and colours.

Rich Tasks and Investigations

This term our topic is called, 'War of the Worlds'. The pupils will play an active role in deciding what they wish to learn. During their pupil voice session, they will suggest what they would like to learn about this topic and help develop our lines of inquiry for this term.

Health and Wellbeing

Pupils will participate in 2 PE lessons weekly and exploring their 'Dreams and Goals' and discussing 'Being Me In My World' during their PSE lessons.

Behaviour

We use a Good to Be Green focus in school that aims to promote and celebrate pupils who always do their best whilst offering some guidance and support should pupils require it. Dojo Points will continue to be the reward system for the class.
