

Manor Adventure Final Details

Essential kit

The full kit list and list of the activities we will be enjoying can be found on the Penyrenghlyn Manor Adventure webpage. Please pay close attention to what is needed and ensure your child is aware of what clothing is being packed, preferably labelled so that any confusion can be avoided, this helps them when they are packing up on Sunday.

I must emphasise that pupils will need a pillow, pillow case and sleeping bag for this weekend.

Technology Detox

Absolutely **NO** digital devices are allowed during this residential. This includes: mobile phones, tablets, camera or MP3 players. Pupils may wish to have a magazine, book or even playing cards with them but there will be very few opportunities for "downtime".

Money

However, no more than £5 spending money in loose change please, as there are vending machines in some areas. (Money to be put in a named purse/wallet please.) Midnight snacks are of course, acceptable but please no nuts as we know we have some children with allergies. Be sensible with the quantities of food that is packed as the pupils will need to be carrying their luggage up 2 flights of stairs!

Updates Via Class Dojo

We will be posting pictures and brief updates about the gorups visit whenever we get the opportunity to upload. We will be entirely focused on ensuring the pupils are safe, happy and enjoying their experiences. We will not be responding to individual messages from families unless it is an absolute emergency. Departure

On Friday we anticipate that we will begin loading the bus at approximately 12:30. Once the bus and pupils are ready we will aim to be leaving no later than 13:00. If you wish to wave your child off as we depart please allow for arrival in good time as we will not be able to wait. We are checking into the residence at 14:30 and will begin activities following a firesafety talk and brief welcome from the Abernant staff.

Return

We anticipate leaving Abernant Center no later than 13:30. Pupils will be fed prior to departure. I will update families using the class Dojo on the estimated return time. Currently we hope to be back at Penyrenglyn Primary school on Sunday the 1st of May at approximately 15:00.

Medical information

All pupils requiring medicine during the residential should have completed and returned the full permission slip that grants myself the authority and responsibility to oversee and store the necessary medicine, without this permission I will not be able to administer and record their usage. I require the medicine be handed to me with the clear Doctors instructions attached no later than Friday morning (Handing it to me as we step on the bus is not an option I am afraid).
