How to support your child at home

Counting - forwards and backwards to
support addition and subtraction. Counting up
to 20 and beyond.

Reading - with your child for at least 10
minutes daily. Read together, read to your
child and/or listen to them read.

the correct formation.

activities and resources.

Curriculum

Our theme this term is All About Me. Throughout the term
we will be learning about the all the things that make us who we
are and looking at what make us the same and different from
others.

Mathematics and Numeracy

We will continue to use a range of resources from our Fast
Forward Maths and Abacus schemes. These aim to accelerate
pupils' mathematical skills and provide them with authentic
contexts in which to develop their knowledge of the number
system, including weighing, measuring and time.

Language, Literacy and Communication

Each fortnight, or so, we will visit a new book, either fiction or
non-fiction, or a song or rhyme.

We continue to use phonics and to develop reading skills as well
as trying to foster a love of books throughout all areas of the
curriculum.

We will be learning how to write using finger spaces, full stops
and capital letters.

Welsh

We will be learning the basic vocabulary and sentence patterns
to incorporate the Welsh language into our daily conversation.

Forest School

We will be visiting our Forest School on given dates this term.
These dates will be posted on the class page on our website.

Rich Tasks and Investigations

This term we are undertaking short term investigations that
will be stimulated by a range of texts under the concept of
communication. We will cover the full range of Areas of
Learning to ensure a rich and stimulating curriculum.

Health and Wellbeing

We will be developing our fine motor skills during sessions to
support the development and our topic will allow the children to
learn about themselves so they can identify what makes them
happy and healthy.

We will continue to use our Good to Be Green focus in school
