How to support your child at home

Counting - forwards and backwards to support addition and subtraction. Counting in 10s, 2's and 5s to 100 and beyond.

Reading - with your child for at least 10 minutes daily. Read together, read to your child and/or listen to them read.

Curriculum

Our theme this term is Celebrations/Festivals.

Throughout the term we will be learning about the importance of water, water sources and water safety.

Mathematics and Numeracy

We will continue to use a range of resources from our Abacus scheme. These aim to accelerate pupils' mathematical skills and provide them with authentic contexts in which to develop their knowledge of the number system, including weighing, measuring and time.

Language, Literacy and Communication

Each fortnight, or so, we will visit a new book, either fiction or non-fiction, or a song or rhyme.

We continue to use phonics and guided reading sessions to develop reading skills as well as trying to foster a love of books throughout all areas of the curriculum.

We will be learning how to write persuasively this term. We will continue to learn how to use finger spaces, full stops and capital letters when writing our words.

Welsh

We will be learning vocabulary and sentence patterns linked to the relevant year group topic and using incidental Welsh throughout the day.

Forest School

We will be visiting our Forest School on given dates this term. These dates will be posted on the class page on our website.

Rich Tasks and Investigations

This term we are undertaking short term investigations that will be stimulated by a range of texts. We will cover the full range of Areas of Learning to ensure a rich and stimulating curriculum.
