These updates need not be presented as lengthy written reports, but rather, we will employ the most appropriate format as determined by the head teacher. Our aim is to present this information to you in an accessible manner, which maximises engagement and understanding on your part.

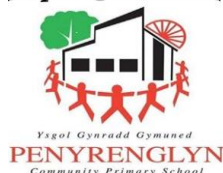

It is of paramount importance that the information and feedback we provide to you is easily understood. Therefore, our communication will be concise, free from technical jargon, and tailored to meet your needs as parents and carers. We believe that embracing the principles of progression can serve as an effective framework and narrative for our conversations with you.

While personalised assessment reports are a statutory requirement, we consider this to be just a small component of the larger communication and engagement process.
